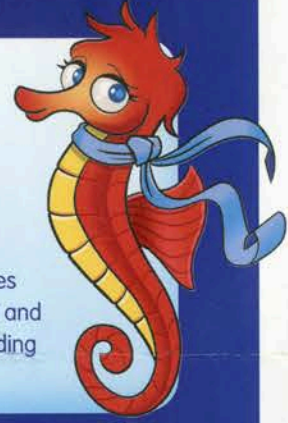


SEALIFE

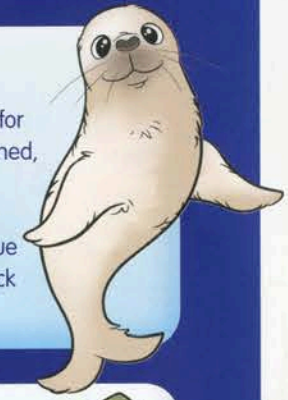
Breeding Vulnerable Species

Breeding programmes are an essential part of protecting our marine heritage. SEA LIFE Centres and Sanctuaries run the largest and most successful seahorse breeding programme in the world.



Rescuing Seals

Every year we rescue and care for many seal pups found abandoned, lost or injured on our local beaches. After specialist care and treatment in our Seal Rescue Centre they are all released back into the wild.



Protecting Native Crayfish

We work in partnership with angling associations to help maintain a healthy balance of American Signal Crayfish and vulnerable British Crayfish in our local rivers.



We're proud to support The SEA LIFE Trust which is working to protect marine wildlife. The Trust is funding Whale & Dolphin Conservation's work to help protect whales from being hunted. Funding has also been given to projects to rehabilitate sea turtles, protect sharks, rays and reef fish, and many more worthy causes will benefit in the future.
