Shaped like a Torpedo, Humboldt penguins can reach speeds of up to 20mph.

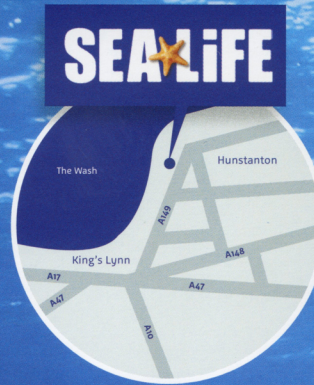

## Explore our amazing creature zones

Start your undersea journey of discovery at the magnificent Ray and Native Waters zone and find lobsters, seahorses, British sharks and majestic rays. Get hands on at our Interactive Rockpool before meeting our adorable Humboldt penguins. Explore the Rainforests of the World and see caiman crocodiles before entering Clownfish Kingdom, where you can spot tiny shrimps and venomous fish from the world's tropical oceans. Learn about our rescued seal pups in the Seal Hospital. Watch our playful family of otters outside before re-entering and being amazed at Ernie, our giant green sea turtle as he swims amongst several species of tropical sharks and rays as you walk underwater through the Ocean Tunnel. Our Rainforest Rangers are waiting to show you some of their jungle beasts and creepy crawlies at our special creature handling sessions at the Rainforest Ranger Base Camp.

## Wow factor

The Norfolk coast is home to both common and grey seals. The population of common seals found in the Wash is one of the largest in Europe and since opening in 1989 we have rescued and released hundreds of baby seals.



We're proud to support our partner charity The SEA LIFE Trust which is working to protect marine wildlife and habitats across the world. Together we have run successful campaigns to protect whales from hunting, to reduce plastic litter and to create new protected areas in the oceans.
